- Qualifications for most competitive scholarships include: 3.7+ GPA, evidence of leadership, ambition, engagement in campus & community activities, writing, speaking and critical thinking skills. Some scholarships may require research or policy experience.
- Many successful candidates have study abroad experience and/or multiple majors.
- Mitchell candidates should not already be Irish Studies focused (but may wish to study Irish literature or culture in Ireland).
- Soros candidates must be newly naturalized Americans or the child of two naturalized parents.
- Arts & Humanities students with a strong record in public service may also be eligible for the [Truman Scholarship](#) and the [Samuel Huntington Public Service Award](#).
- Arts & Humanities students with a passion for the environment may also be eligible for the [Udall Scholarship](#).
